- Zoning Officer Stranahan has been making a list of all signs within the Town of Attica. These signs will be grandfathered into the new zoning laws, but residents will need to submit a sign application for each, there will not be a charge for any sign already in place at the time the new zoning laws were approved by the State.

- State Senate and Assembly have both approved rifle hunting within Wyoming County, the Bill is still waiting for the Governor of NYS to approve. Once signed, there will be rifle hunting allowed in Wyoming County.
